



THE WRONG WAY.....

- When it comes to native trees and plants, every precaution can be a life saver.
- Barricades could have prevented the damage seen below.



Trunk damage to a slash pine will likely cause the tree to die.



Slash pines that are root raked may not survive.

What to look for when putting up your tree's barricade:

- ✓ Follow along the tree or plant's dripline.
- ✓ Remember to protect the understory plants.
- ✓ Use brightly colored material for your barricade.
- ✓ Use a barricade that is easily seen from the ground up.
