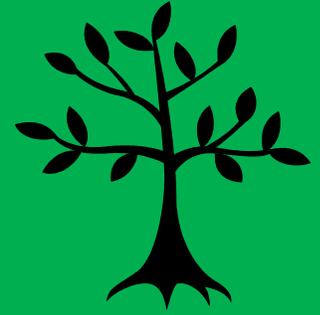


TREE REPLACEMENT TABLE



Article 14.C. of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) requires that existing native vegetation be incorporated into development plan designs or be relocated on site to vegetation buffers and open spaces.

Non-relocatable native vegetation which cannot be maintained on the parcel must be mitigated in accordance with Section 14.C ULDC. All palms with 8 feet of trunk and all trees 6 inches dbh (diameter at breast height), are considered to be potentially relocatable and must be utilized to the greatest extent possible on site.

NOTE: ALL REQUIRED MITIGATION FOR THE REMOVAL OF NATIVE TREES ARE IN ADDITION TO LANDSCAPING REQUIREMENTS (ARTICLE 7 - ULDC) AS WELL AS ANY OTHER CONDITION OF APPROVAL BY PALM BEACH COUNTY ZONING DIVISION OR THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

CROWN SPREAD OF TREE	OR	DIAMETER AT 4.5 FT. ABOVE GRADE	=	CREDITS OR REPLACEMENTS
Less than 5 Feet	or	Less than 2 inches	=	0
5-9 Feet	or	2 - 6 Inches	=	1
10 - 19 Feet	or	7 - 11 Inches	=	2
20 - 29 Feet	or	12 - 16 Inches	=	3
30 - 39 Feet	or	17 - 21 Inches	=	4
40 - 49 Feet	or	22 - 26 Inches	=	5
50 - 59 Feet	or	27 - 31 Inches	=	6
60 - 89 Feet	or	32 - 36 Inches	=	7
90 Feet or Greater	or	37 Inches or More	=	8
