Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB)

Overview

The CILB establishes and enforces contractor qualifications and competencies within Palm Beach County. It administers certification examinations, processes status-change requests, and holds the authority to suspend or revoke county contractor licenses for violations of certification laws.

Responsibilities

- Review all certification examinations and reciprocal applications
- Process certification status-change requests
- Investigate and take disciplinary action against certified contractors

Board Composition & Terms

The CILB comprises 15 members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, reflecting both industry expertise and consumer interests:

- 2 General Contractors
- 1 Building Contractor
- 1 Residential Contractor
- 1 Architect
- 1 Engineer
- 1 Full-time Building Official (must meet Building Officials Association of Florida requirements and reside in Palm Beach County)
- 1 Roofing Contractor
- 1 Swimming Pool Contractor
- 3 Consumer Members

Each member serves a three-year term and may be reappointed for a second consecutive term. Following two terms, a three-year hiatus is required before reconsideration.
