RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION DOA1986-131A
DEVELOPMENT ORDER AMENDMENT
PETITION OF FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT
BY FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT, AGENT
(FPL CORBETT SUBSTATION)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements, as provided for in Article 5 of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Zoning Petition DOA1986-131A was presented to the Board of County Commissioners at a public hearing conducted on March 25, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the petitioner and other interested parties, and the recommendations of the various county review agencies; and

WHEREAS, this approval is subject to Article 5, Section 5.8 (Compliance with Time Limitations), of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code and other provisions requiring that development commence in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the findings in the staff report and the following findings of fact:

1. This Development Order Amendment is consistent with the Palm Beach County Comprehensive Plan.
2. This Development Order Amendment complies with the relevant and appropriate portions of Article 6, Supplementary Use Standards; of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code.
3. This Development Order Amendment is consistent with the requirements of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code.
4. This Development Order Amendment, with conditions as adopted, is compatible as defined in the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code and generally consistent with the uses and character of the land surrounding and in the vicinity of the land proposed for development.
5. This Development Order Amendment, with conditions as adopted, complies with the standards imposed on it by applicable provisions of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code for use, layout, function, and general development characteristics.
6. This Development Order Amendment meets applicable local land development regulations.
7. This Development Order Amendment, with conditions as adopted, minimizes adverse effects, including visual impact and intensity of the proposed use on adjacent lands.
8. This Development Order Amendment has a concurrency determination and complies with Article 11 (Adequate Public Facility Standards) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code.

9. This Development Order Amendment, with conditions as adopted, minimizes environmental impacts, including but not limited to water, air, stormwater management, wildlife, vegetation, wetlands and the natural functioning of the environment.
10. This Development Order Amendment, with conditions as adopted, will result in logical, timely and orderly development patterns.

WHEREAS, Article 5 of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Zoning Petition DOA1986-131A, the petition of Florida Power & Light, by Florida Power & Light, agent, for a Development Order Amendment to add land area and reconfigure the site plan on a parcel of land legally described in EXHIBIT A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and generally located as shown on a vicinity sketch attached as EXHIBIT B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, was approved on March 25, 2004, subject to the conditions of approval described in EXHIBIT C, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Commissioner McCarty moved for the approval of the Resolution.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A parcel of land lying in Section 20, Township 43 South, Range 40 East, said parcel described as being the East 1560 feet, of the West 1645 feet, of the South 761 feet, of said Section 20, as measured along South and West lines thereof.

Together with, a parcel of land lying in Section 29, Township 43 South, Range 40 East, said parcel described as being the East 1560 feet, of the West 1645 feet, of the North 589 feet, of said section 29, as measured along the North and West lines thereof.
Said lands situate in Palm Beach County, Florida and containing 2,105,982 sq. ft (48.347 acres) more or less.

(Zoning Quad Map 107)




EXHIBIT C

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

NOTE: All previous conditions of approval are shown in **BOLD** and will be carried forward with this petition unless expressly modified.

A. ALL PETITIONS

1. All previous conditions of approval applicable to the subject property, as contained in Resolution R-1987-511 (Petition 1986-131) has been consolidated as contained herein. The petitioner shall comply with all previous conditions of approval and deadlines previously established by Section 5.8 of the ULDC and the Board of County Commissioners, unless expressly modified. (ONGOING: MONITORING – Zoning)
2. Development of the site is limited to the uses and site design as approved by the Board of County Commissioners. The approved site plan is dated February 4, 2004. All modifications must be approved by the Board of County Commissioners unless the proposed changes are required to meet conditions of approval or are in accordance with the ULDC. (ONGOING: ZONING – Zoning)
3. Condition 1 of Resolution R-1987-511, Petition 1986-131 which currently states:

Prior to site plan certification, the site plan shall be amended to include the following:

- a. **The requirements of Section 500.35. E. (Minimum Landscape Requirements), or variance relief shall be obtained.**
- b. **The required number of parking spaces (based on employment).**

Is hereby deleted. [REASON: code requirement.]

B. COMPLIANCE

1. In granting this approval, the Board of County Commissioners relied upon the oral and written representations of the petitioner both on the record and as part of the application process. Deviations from or violation of these representations shall cause the approval to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for review under the compliance condition of this approval. (ONGOING: MONITORING - Zoning)
2. Failure to comply with any of the conditions of approval for the subject property at any time may result in:
 - a. The issuance of a stop work order; the issuance of a cease and desist order; the denial or revocation of a building permit; the denial or revocation of a Certificate of Occupancy; the denial of any other permit, license or approval to any developer, owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; the revocation of any other permit, license or approval from any developer, owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; revocation of any concurrency; and/or
 - b. The revocation of the Official Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or any other zoning approval; and/or

- c. A requirement of the development to conform with the standards of the ULDC at the time of the finding of non-compliance, or the addition or modification of conditions reasonably related to the failure to comply with existing conditions; and/or
- d. Referral to code enforcement; and/or
- e. Imposition of entitlement density or intensity.

Staff may be directed by the Executive Director of PZ&B or a Code Enforcement Special Master to schedule a Status Report before the body which approved the Official Zoning Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or other zoning approval, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.8 of the ULDC, in response to any flagrant violation and/or continued violation of any condition of approval.

Appeals of any departmental administrative actions hereunder may be taken to the Palm Beach County Board of Adjustment or as otherwise provided in the Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as amended. Appeals of any revocation of an Official Zoning Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment or other actions based on a Board of County Commission decision shall be by petition for writ of certiorari to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit. (ONGOING: MONITORING – Zoning)

There are no Conditions of Approval C or D for this request.

E. ENGINEERING

1. Condition E.2 of Resolution R-1987-511, Petition 1986-131, which currently states:

The developer shall retain the stormwater runoff in accordance in all applicable agency requirements in effect at the time of the permit application. However, at a minimum, this development shall retain onsite 85% of the stormwater runoff generated by a three (3) year-one hour storm per requirements of the Permit Section, Land Development Division. The drainage system shall be maintained in an acceptable condition as approved by the County Engineer. In the event that the drainage system is not adequately maintained as determined by the County Engineer, this matter shall be submitted to the Code Enforcement Board for review and possible citation. (ONGOING: MONITORING – Eng)

Is hereby deleted: [REASON: Code requirement.]
